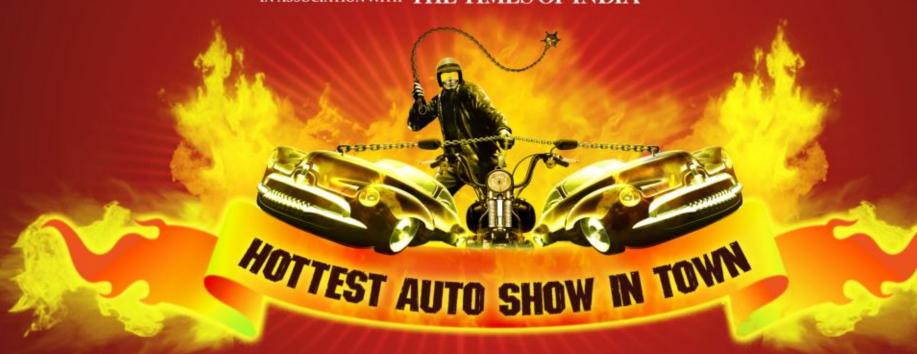


RELIO QUICK AUTO MALL 2010 "INDIA'S LARGEST MULTICITY AUTOMOBILE EXHIBITION"

After the phenomenal success of Relio Quick Auto Mall in 2009 at Delhi, Chandigarh & Bangalore, the 2010 season started with Chandigarh edition in Feb 2010 in stupendous manner followed by Mumbai edition from 5th to 7th March at Bandra Kurla Complex, Mumbai. The Mumbai edition turned out to be the biggest ever Auto Show in the city of Mumbai. Our interaction with the participants and visitors revealed that Auto Mall was a right platform for industry to show case their products and reach out to customers in an organized manner at one place.

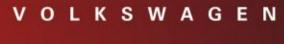
